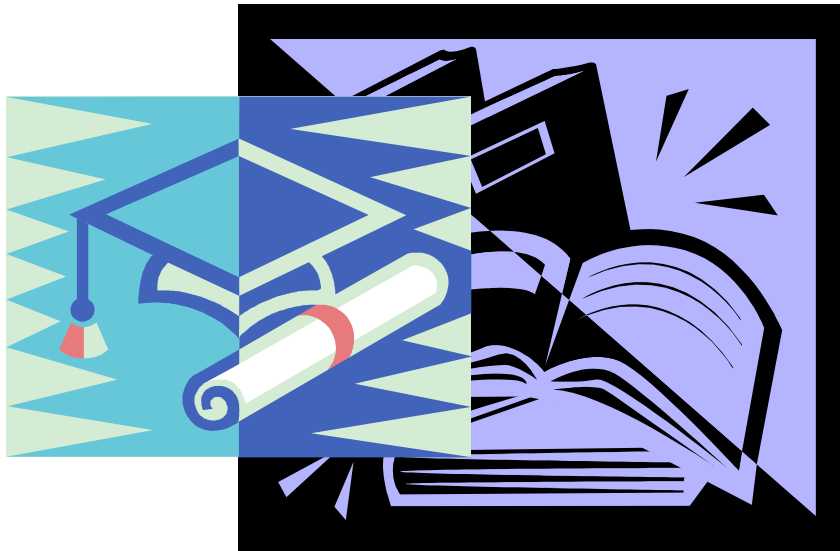

1. Eligibility

Applicants' eligibility is based on "MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan". If the MOE Regulations are updated, these Regulations announced by the MOE will take priority. For updated information relating to the MOE Regulations, please contact the MOE directly.

- (1) Applicants must qualify for legal student status in compliance with Article 2 of the Ministry of Education's Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan". International students are defined as follows:
 - a. Individuals of foreign nationality, who has never held nationality status from the Republic of China and does not possess an overseas Chinese student status at the time of application, are qualified to apply for admission under this regulation.
 - b. Individuals of foreign nationality, pursuant to the following regulations and who held residency overseas continuously for no less than 6 years, are also qualified to apply for admission under this regulation.
 - i. An individual who also is a national of the R.O.C., but does not hold or has had a household registration in Taiwan.
 - ii. An individual who also was a national of the R.O.C. but has no R.O.C. nationality at the time of their application shall have an annulled status regarding their R.O.C. nationality for no less than 8 years after an annulment of R.O.C. nationality by the Ministry of the Interior.
 - iii. Regarding individuals mentioned in both of the above articles must not have studied in Taiwan as overseas Chinese student nor received placement permission during the same year of the application by the University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students.
 - c. According to the Education Cooperation Framework Agreement, a foreign national, who was selected by a foreign government, organization, or school and does not hold a R.O.C. household registration from the time of his/her birth is not subject to the limitations as prescribed in Paragraph 2, is eligible to apply with approval from Ministry of Education.
 - d. An applicant of foreign nationality, concurrently holding a permanent residence status in Hong Kong or Macao, having no history of a household registration record in Taiwan and, at the time of application, has resided in Hong Kong, Macao, or another foreign country continuously for no less than 6 years.
 - e. An applicant being a former citizen of Mainland China and holds a foreign nationality, having no history of household registration record in Taiwan, and at the time of application, has resided overseas continuously for no less than 6 years.
- (2) Upon completion of the course of study, at a school in Taiwan, to which an international student has applied, the student's admission to higher academic levels shall be handled in a manner identical to the procedures of admission for local students. An exception is that an application for a master's degree or higher levels of graduate studies can be processed under the procedures of each individual school.
- (3) An individual who has never been dismissed by other universities in Taiwan.
- (4) During the course of study in Taiwan, international students, who have undertaken initial household registration, resident registration, naturalization or restoration of the R.O.C. nationality, will lose their international student status and shall be dismissed by the school.
- (5) During the course of study in Taiwan, international students, who have undertaken initial household registration, resident registration, naturalization or restoration of the R.O.C. nationality, will lose their international student status and shall be dismissed by the school.

Violation of any regulation of MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan will result in immediate cancellation of the applicant's admission or the deprivation of the applicant's recognized status as NSYSU registered student, or revocation of applicant's NSYSU diploma. No certificates will be awarded.

Notes:

- i. According to Article 2 of the "Nationality Law" of R.O.C., a person shall have the nationality of the Republic of China under any of the conditions provided by the following subparagraphs:
 - (i) His/Her father or mother was a national of the Republic of China when he/she was born.
 - (ii) He/She was born after the death of his/her father or mother, and his/her father or mother was a national of the Republic of China at the time of death.
 - (iii) He/She was born in the territory of the Republic of China, and his/her parents cannot be ascertained or

both were stateless people.

(iv) He/She has undergone the nationalization process.

Preceding subparagraph 1 and subparagraph 2 shall also apply to the persons who were minors at the time of the revision and promulgation of this Act.

ii. The "overseas" prescribed in Paragraph 2 is limited to countries or regions other than Mainland China, Hong Kong and Macau; the term "continuously" means that an individual may stay in Taiwan for no more than a total of 120 days per calendar year.

iii. The calculation of the 6 and 8 year period prescribed in Paragraph 2 can only be counted up to the starting date of the semester, August 1st 2017.

3. How to Apply

- (1) Application form can **ONLY** be completed online. Please visit <http://oiasys.oia.nsysu.edu.tw/>
- (2) Please complete application procedure online, print, sign and upload the following forms: (1) application form, (2) statutory declaration form, (3) statement of declaration, and (4) Application for NSYSU Scholarship (if applicable). **Applications received after the deadline will not be processed.**
- (3) Upload other required documents to the application system.
- (4) Each applicant may apply for two undergraduate/graduate programs at most, and one group within one undergraduate/graduate program at most; when applying for two undergraduate/graduate programs, please submit required documents individually for each program and indicate your preference on the application form.
- (5) All documents submitted with the application will not be returned regardless of applicant's admission status. Please keep personal copy for future reference.

4. Online Admission Application

Applicants must **upload** the following documents to the online application system by March 31st 2017.

- (1) Application Form with signature: the form will be generated automatically after completing the online application form.
- (2) The "Statutory Declaration form" and "Statement of Declaration on Foreign Academic Background" with signature: both forms will be generated automatically after completing the online application form.
- (3) Application for NSYSU Scholarship for International Students (if applicable): the form will be generated automatically after completing the online admission application form.
- (4) Certificate of Nationality Renouncement of Republic of China (if applicable):
Required for applicants who once held nationality of the Republic of China. Applicants must have renounced their nationality for at least 8 years from the date of the certificate to the first day of the semester, August 1st 2017.

- (5) Certificate of Highest-Level Diploma and Transcript:
 - a. One photocopy of diploma
 - For undergraduate programs, please provide high school diploma; for graduate programs, please provide Bachelor Degree Diploma; for doctorate programs, please provide Master's Degree Diploma.
 - If you are currently studying at an institute, please submit **an authorized statement of anticipated graduation time** issued by the institute.
 - For Taiwanese university graduates, please submit diploma in CHINESE.
 - b. One photocopy of translated diploma if the original is not in Chinese or English
 - Must be issued by institute which the applicant has graduated from.
 - c. One photocopy of transcript
 - Applicants for Ph.D. program should provide both undergraduate and graduate transcripts.
 - d. One photocopy of translated transcript, if the original is not in Chinese or English
 - Must be issued by the institute which applicant has graduated from.
- (6) One photocopy of financial statement issued by a bank in the country which the applicant resides.
 - a. All applicants must provide a financial statement of at least USD\$5,000.
 - b. If the financial statement is not in the name of the applicant, a declaration with signature from the sponsor must be included, stating the relationship with the applicant and guaranteeing responsibility for all of applicant's expenses in Taiwan.
- (7) A photocopy of Certificate of Nationality: i.e. passport, residence certificate or birth certificate.
- (8) Other materials required by specific Undergraduate/Graduate Programs (if applicable):
 - a. Please refer to required documents of each department/institute from page 8.
- (9) Other materials required by NSYSU Scholarship for International Students (if applicable).
 - a. Please refer to "Items of Documents for NSYSU Scholarship" on the application form.

※Applications without any of the documents (1)~(7) will not be considered as qualified and will not be passed to the departments for final assessment.

5. Registration

- (1) All admitted students must submit "Admission Acceptance Form" before the deadline. NSYSU Letter of Acceptance will be emailed and mailed to admitted students who have submitted the above form in time.
 Note: All admitted students must submit the above documents before the deadline. Please be aware that if the documents failed to be submitted before the deadline, the admission will be given to applicants on the waiting list.
- (2) All admitted students must submit the following documents upon registration.
 - a. The highest degree diploma and transcript authenticated with official stamps by the R.O.C. Embassies, Consulate Offices, Missions abroad or by other Notary Institutes authorized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, R.O.C. (These documents will be returned). If the diploma and transcript are not in Chinese or English, an authenticated translation in English or Chinese is required; for applicants who graduated from a Taiwanese university, please submit CHINESE degree diploma and transcript and they are not required for further authentication.
 - b. All admitted students are required to provide proof of personal health insurance or proof of National Health Insurance (NHI). Please be aware that personal health insurance certificate must be authenticated by the R.O.C. Embassy, Consulate Office, or Taipei Economic & Culture Office in the country which the student resides.
 - c. All admitted students are required to acquire "Alien Resident Certificate" (ARC) and submit a copy (both side) to the Office of International Affairs at Room 1006 Administration building before Oct 31st, 2017.
- (3) Academic year: August 1st ~ July 31st
 Fall semester: Mid-September ~ Mid-January

Spring semester: Mid-February ~ Mid-June

- (4) All admitted students should complete registration accordingly. Failure to complete registration procedure is regarded as forfeiting admitted status.
- (5) Admitted students who completed five-year high school must take extra credits and subject in accordance with respective department graduation requirements.

Note:

***If the submitted documents be found forged, fraudulent or altered, etc., students' admitted status will be cancelled or students' registered status will be revoked; no degree certificate will be given.**

Remarks:

- i. "Extended study" refers to the student who is in 5th year of Bachelors or 3rd year of Masters and Ph.Ds.
 - ii. All extended study students with 9 credits or less are charged credit and miscellaneous fees, and will be charged as full tuition fee if more than 10 credits.
 - iii. For master and Ph.D. students with extended study who have completed all courses but incompleteness of thesis are required to register and are charged miscellaneous fees.
 - iv. The above are estimated tuition rates for the 2017-2018 academic year. The actual tuition fee will be announced on the relevant date.
- c. Students admitted to NSYSU via Education Cooperation Framework Agreement (such as Taiwan Scholarship, VEST500 and other similar programs) shall pay for tuition fees in accordance with the agreements.
- (2) Insurance fee: it is mandatory for international students living in Taiwan to join the National Health Insurance (NHI) after acquiring the ARC (Alien Resident Certificate) for 6 months and the insurance fee will be included in the tuition fees payment form. Students are required to provide proof of personal health insurance upon registration prior to joining the NHI for the period from September 2017~ February 2018.
 - (3) Dormitory fee: NSYSU provides on-campus housing. Dormitory fee is approximately NT\$34,000 per academic year (not including summer and winter breaks). Students may submit application forms for housing

after being admitted. Rooms are assigned on a first-come-first-served basis.

- (4) Other fees: Expenses on textbooks vary depending on the fields of study. Fees for meals are approximately NT\$7,000 to NT\$9,000 per month.

7. Chinese Language Proficiency

Application who are unable to maintain good standing in course work due to language difficulties will be encouraged to take Chinese language courses at his/her own expense at the Chinese Language Centre, NSYSU. ※ Bachelor's programs are all taught in Chinese, applicants need to fulfill required Chinese language proficiency.

8. Visa

10. Part-Time Job Opportunities

After studying in a degree program in Taiwan and holding a student ARC, international students are eligible to apply for work permit for both on- and off-campus jobs. International students may work up to 20 hours per week, with the exception of summer and winter vacations. Foreigners working in Taiwan are required to file an income tax in May each year. Details concerning foreigners working in Taiwan are specified in the "Regulations on the Permission and Administration of the Employment of Foreign Workers" at <http://law.moj.gov.tw/Eng/LawClass/LawContent.aspx?PCODE=N0090027>.

11. Notes

- (1) Application period for Fall 2017 Semester for international students begins on January 15th, 2017. Required documents and related regulations are specified in the "MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan".
- (2) Applications received after the deadline will not be accepted and not be considered for admission. Applicants alone are solely responsible if incomplete items delays in admission process. All documents submitted with the application will not be returned regardless of applicant's admission status. Please keep personal copy for future reference.
- (3) The admission process of international students is stipulated by the "MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan" (Note: for more information, please visit the Ministry of Education website: <http://english.moe.gov.tw/>).
- (4) Once official admission announcement has been made, admitted international students must submit the required documents before the deadline. Applicants who have not confirmed by deadline will be regarded as to forfeit their admitted status, and the admission will be given to applicants on the waiting list.
